Welcome to Community Players and Les Misérables. Les Mis has run continuously in London since 1985, making it the second longest-running musical in the world. On Broadway it ran for 6,680 performances, the fourth longest-running Broadway show in history.

A lot of very hard work has gone into this show. You will hear wonderful singing (in this show there are very few spoken words, only singing) and great music from our orchestra. What you don't see is all of the time and effort to build the sets, find props, get the lighting just right for each scene, sew all of the costumes, make sure everyone can be heard, switch microphones, put on makeup, sell ads, put together the program, sell tickets, put up signs, moving sets, collecting tickets — the list goes on and on. These things are done by a very dedicated group of people who don't do it for the applause but because they love being involved with community theater.

A lot will be happening this year. After 40 years plus in our home on Glen Avenue, Community Players will be moving the day after *Les Misérables* closes. We are purchasing a building on Nutters Cross Road that is three times the size of our current buildings. After some major renovations we will be able to have auditions and rehearsals in our own space.
